The CMS Endowment Grant funding has been used to cover expenses relating to Nipissing University Mathematics Education, Research and Information Centre's (NUMERIC) second annual Mathematics Fair which was held on April 27th, 2009. Remaining funds will be used to cover expenses relating to our Gr 9/10 Mathematics Competition to be held on December 11, 2009, and relating to our Gr 11/12 Mathematics Competition to be held on May 7, 2010.

Assessment of Effectiveness:

The Mathematics Fair was once again a successful event with students from Grades 7-12 entering their projects in different categories.
